ACA Domestic Season 2025-26 Guidelines

The ACA Domestic Season for 2024-25 will commence on 28th May 2024. To ensure a smooth and well-organized tournament, the following guidelines are issued for participating and host districts:

Guidelines for Participating Districts:

- 1. **Team Composition**: Each team can have a maximum of 15 players.
- 2. **Team Management**: Each team must nominate only one coach or manager for the tournament.
- 3. **Team Submission**:
 - Email Submission: The team list, including the date of birth of each player, must be emailed to Gm-Game Development, ACA at least two days before the tournament starts.
 - Hard Copy Submission: A hard copy of the team list, with date of birth certificates certified by the Hon. Secretary of the District Cricket Association, must reach the ACA office before the tournament concludes.
 - The same shall be carried by Team Coach or Manager to the Venue of the tournament.
- 4. **Registration in ODMS**: Teams must register in the Online Data Management System (ODMS) provided to the concerned district at least 48 hours before the tournament starts.
- 5. Uniform Requirements:
 - o Teams participating in white ball tournaments must wear colored clothing and pads.
 - The colored clothing must not have any white portions to ensure the batter can sight the ball properly

Guidelines for Host Districts:

- 1. **Accommodation**: Provide decent accommodation for visiting teams, match officials, cricket talent committee and selectors.
 - o Accommodation for visiting teams is limited to 15 players and one coach or manager.
 - Match officials, cricket talent committee and selectors will be accommodated on a double occupancy basis.
- 2. **Meals and Water**: Ensure all meals and water are served to the visiting teams, as no daily allowance (DA) is provided.
- 3. **Local Travel**: Arrange local travel from accommodation to the ground and back if the accommodation is not at the game venue.
- 4. **Game Requirements**: Ensure all necessary game requirements are provided, including sight screens, designated areas for players and match officials, and clean toilets.
- 5. **Scoring Facilities**: Provide uninterrupted power supply and Wi-Fi for the scorer, as scoring will be done online.
- 6. **Budget Approval**: Send the tournament budget to ACA for approval before the tournament starts
- 7. Post-Tournament Responsibilities:
 - Collect information on the selected team from the selectors in a sealed cover and forward it to ACA.
 - Forward the filled-in score sheets and captains' reports provided by the scorer to ACA

Adhering to these guidelines will help ensure the smooth conduct and organization of the ACA Domestic Season 2025-26.
